Per the Kentucky Derby web site, "The Kentucky Derby is the longest running sporting event in the United States"* and has been referred to as "the most exciting two minutes in sports"*. This 1.25-mile horse race, conducted every May since 1875, has produced notable winners such as War Admiral, Secretariat, Seattle Slew, and American Pharoah, each a Triple Crown Winner, and for which Secretariat holds the record for the "fastest" race-time (1:59.4 minutes ${ }^{\wedge}$ ).
